### **JYOTISHA BASICS I**

It will serve as a pre-requisite to an upcoming series of weekends (next one is scheduled for October 24<sup>th</sup>, 2009) designed to give coherent traditional instruction in the Vidya of Jyotisha.

## WEEKDAY SESSIONS: August 31<sup>st</sup>, September 1 and September 2nd

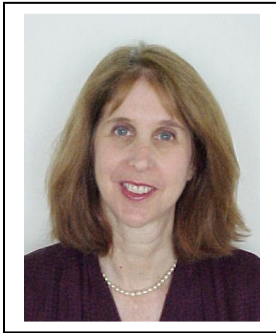
