WEEKDAY SESSIONS: October 26th, 27th and 28th

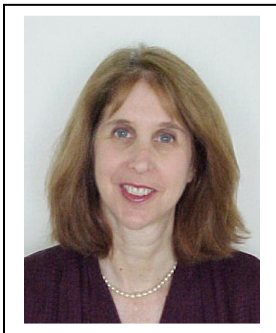
