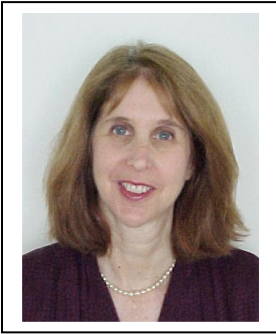
**Pre-requisite is Jyotisha Basics I or permission of the instructor. Fee is \$50 per day.**
