

**Safety Measures against COVID-19 at AVG - We at the Gurukulam take the safety of our students, visitors, and staff seriously. Due to the pandemic we have implemented the following:**

- All visitors, workers, and campers are pre-screened by self-reporting of symptoms which may be due to COVID-19 or exposures to COVID-19
- All indoor public area capacity has been reduced to 25%
- Routine temperature checks are performed on arrival and before entering classes
- All visitors, workers, and campers are mandated to wear facemasks in all indoor settings
- The social distancing of 6 feet or more is enforced with stickers on the ground and blocking off seating in the auditorium and dining hall
- Hand sanitizer and disposable napkins are placed at all major entrances
- EPA approved sterilizing liquid is used for fogging routinely in public areas and in cabins after checkout
- High capacity filters and UV light are used to clean the air circulated in the auditorium and temple hall
- The humidity in the auditorium and dining hall has been increased to 50% so as to decrease the potential of airborne transmission
- Frequent handwashing is encouraged

**To be implemented soon:**

- Industrial air filters are being installed in auditorium ductwork and include Merv 13 high efficiency particulate filters (recommended against viruses by CDC),
- high-intensity UV light, mesh paneling coated with Titanium dioxide which releases hydroxyl groups eliminating all organic matter.
